This is not true. Neither is the implication that is only required because of EB or EC. There are other scenarios where interoperability is equally important.	Revise to indicate that the scope of 19763 is broader.

GB 04	6.1.1	Figure 2	ed	The dashed line from the XOR note to the SLA association between Registry and Document is almost hidden under the dashed line to the association between Interface and Document.	Separate dashed lines.	
GB 05	6.1.1	Para 13, line 1	ed	Typo	Delete "... the SAL ...", insert "... the SLA ..."
