## 2 Review of Action Items

Bryan sent in the following update:

My understanding of the PAS position is:

UML: The ball is in OMG's court to carry out some edits to fix the readability of some figures and to sort out the position on the numbering of the standard.

I hope it will be possible for Linda to sort out the figures problem this week. Having looked at it, it seems to me that it needs to be sorted out for the OMG text as well.

On the numbering of the standard (19501 not 19501-1), I have checked that this was agreed at the Edting Meetin for the PAS submission and I had assumed that it was simply a matter of incorporating this in the Technical Corrigendum. I have tried to check this with Keith Brannon but have not had a reply so I will try another route.

MOF: As I understand it, there has been no reply from Sridhar on the proposed Preface. I suggest trying Pete Rivett, who was very helpful with the Explanatory Report (as Tom will remember).

CORBA Core: this has not progressed. I will try to get something underway with Jishnu for the London meeting.

### 3 Review of MOF and XMI prefaces and Explanatory report

Sridar explained his changes to the prefaces to MOF, XMI and the joint explanatory report.

The edited preface for MOF (ISO/IEC 19502 )will be placed in liaison 2003-09-01
